<b>Level A Points</b>	established skills and interest in acquiring missing skills (12 to 15 points)	The thesis work was carried out systematically and scientifically (12 to 15 points)	All goals were achieved or exceeded through own ideas and initiative (16 to 20 points)	Exceedingly good and new results were achieved (26 to 30 points)	Exemplary presentation of results (16 to 20 points)
<b>Level B Points</b>	established skills, interest (8 to 11 points)	The thesis work was largely carried out systematically (8 to 11 points)	The thesis work was accomplished autonomously, own ideas were realized (11 to 15 points)	All required results were achieved (18 to 25 points)	Competent and thorough presentation of results (11 to 15 points)
<b>Level C Points</b>	fair skills, acquired skills if necessary (4 to 7 points)	The thesis work was carried out partially systematically (4 to 7 points)	Certain initiative, goal partly achieved (6 to 10 points)	Results were satisfactory (11 to 17 points)	Just the minimum of care to present results (6 to 10 points)
<b>Level D Points</b>	lack of skill, little interest in acquiring new skills (0 to 3 points)	The thesis work was not carried out systematically (0 to 3 points)	Little initiative (0 to 5 points)	Only a minimum of results was achieved (0 to 10 points)	Sloppy presentation (0 to 5 points)
