- Time and cost breakdown
- Evaluation plan

➤ Key details:

- **Funding period:** until 15 March 2027
- **Final payment:** no later than 31 March 2027
- **Maximum funding amount:** €6,000
- **Review:** ongoing by the Vice-President for Research & Transfer, the Central Equal Opportunities Officer and her advisors
- **Elegible to apply:** all members of the uk

weiter:wirken – Fund for innovation in equal opportunities is designed to support projects which, within the context of the uk, actively contribute to structural and cultural change regarding gender equality and thereby address the gender equality aspects set out in Section 4 of the Higher Education Act (HochSchG) and/or the objectives formulated in the uk's Gender Equality Plan 2023–29. Submissions may, for example, aim to strengthen gender equality, promote women's careers, or improve the balance between career and care work, or focus on anti-discrimination.

This may include, for example, the following time-limited measures:

- raising awareness of gender equality across departments,
- skills development for those in leadership positions,
- integrating gender perspectives into study programmes and teaching,
- improving equal opportunities in assessment and selection processes,
- networking among female researchers in the early stages of their careers, and so on.

Please note that individual grants cannot be applied for under this funding line. All members of the University of Koblenz are eligible to apply.
